- Creates crates according to design specifications;
- Operates a sprayer for water based materials including adhesive, latex paint, and lacquer;
- Performs other incidental and related duties as required and assigned.

The ideal candidate will possess the following as minimum qualifications:

- A minimum of three (3) years of college level studio arts training in sculpture or two (2) years of previous crate shop and/or crate packing experience required; extensive experience in-lieu of minimum education may be considered;
- Excellent attention to detail, an understanding of archival materials, museum specifications for crating and packing of museum traveling exhibitions or economical crating methods;
- Three-dimensional packing experience is desired;
- Knowledge of general shop safety and power tools (i.e. table saw, radial arm saw, staplers etc.) and their recommended safety requirements.
